Anglicare NT has provided suicide intervention and awareness training and trainer support within the Northern Territory since 2001. The organisation delivers the LivingWorks developed training programs, the Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) and Suicide SafeTALK (a suicide alertness session), with the aim of reducing the risk of suicide and self-harming behaviour by developing awareness, knowledge, and suicide first aid skills across the community.

Anglicare NT is the lead agency of a local consortium comprised of Danila Dilba Health Service, General Practice Network of the NT and the NT Department of Health, funded to deliver headspace Top End. The service provides a range of direct client services and education/training and community awareness activities. headspace top End is part of a national youth mental health initiative aimed at improving the mental health and wellbeing of young people aged 12 to 25 years. headspace Top End provides early identification and effective evidence based interventions delivered by a range of professionals.

The Youth Mental Health Worker Position is situated in the Youth Health Team and delivers counselling, information and support to young people. Qualifications in Psychology, Social Work or a related degree are essential for this position. The Youth Mental Health worker will also support group work and community awareness activities as required.

Skills and knowledge required include:

- Experience in and demonstrated capacity to effectively deliver direct services to young people.
- Ability to provide Intake and Assessments, Counselling and Support utilising youth friendly evidence based interventions.
- Capacity to provide community awareness, education and training and group work activities as required
- Ability to work well and communicate effectively in a multidisciplinary team.

Salary and conditions for this position are above the relevant Award level, with 5 weeks annual leave and generous salary packaging option available.
