Our goals

Services

Establish a fully integrated, technologyenhanced service offering that is personcentred and responsive to community needs.

- Invest in co-design opportunities and strengthen community feedback so that services best respond to community needs.
- Integrate services, sharing our learnings within and beyond our organisation to support service delivery and system improvements.
- Embed responses to domestic and family violence into all of our services, putting the safety of children first.
- Incorporate greater use of technology in the provision of our services to improve client experience and outcomes.
- Identify opportunities to grow our services in response to community need.

Innovation and advocacy

Use research and evidence to identify areas of need, create innovative responses, measure impact and realise change.

- Strengthen evidence-based practice through program data collection and analysis, outcomes measurement and evaluation across all programs, seeking alignment, where appropriate, with shared frameworks.
- Invest in contemporary data collection and management systems.
- Use research and evidence to identify community-level needs and service gaps and respond to these through service model design and advocacy.
- Identify alternative funding, joint venture and business initiatives to support the development of targeted responses to identified community-level needs.
- Invest in our advocacy capacity to strengthen our voice in community.

Partnerships

Engage in trusted, genuine partnership and capacity building.

- Consolidate our Partnership Support Service offering, including through documenting the elements of our capacity-building support and our methodology.
- Identify opportunities to strengthen existing partnerships, build new partnerships, and evaluate our partnerships.
- Advocate for government or third party investment in identified partnership opportunities to achieve more sustainable outcomes.
- Promote a collaborative approach to tendering and service delivery, and when partnering with Aboriginal Controlled Organisations, supporting them to take the lead.

People

Build on the strength of our staff, grow skilled and diverse leaders, elevate Aboriginal voices and increase lived experience perspectives.

- Strengthen staff wellbeing and explore ways to improve organisational response in this area.
- Increase participation and employment outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres
 Strait Islander Peoples at all levels of the organisation.
- Incorporate the perspectives of people with lived experience at management and governance levels.
- Increase investment in the training and development of all staff, with a focus on leadership development and pathways in both urban, regional and remote offices.
